#### FROM THE CATECHISM...

"The Church which is the Body of Christ participates in the offering of her Head. With him, she herself is offered whole and entire. She unites herself to His intercession with the Father for all men.

In the Eucharist the sacrifice of Christ becomes also the sacrifice of the members of His Body. The lives of the faithful, their praise, sufferings, prayer, and work, are united with those of Christ and with His total offering, and so acquire a new value. Christ's sacrifice present on the altar makes it possible for all generations of Christians to be united with His offering." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, Paragraph 1368)

#### SAINT OF THE MONTH: St. Monica

Born in Algeria in AD 332, Monica was raised a devout Catholic, but married a non -Christian man who spent 20 years verbally abusing her because of her faith. Her son Augustine also fell away from the Church when he grew up. She continually devoted herself to prayers and tears for the conversion of her husband and son. A year before her husband's death, he had a sudden change of heart and was baptized! Her son Augustine also had a miraculous conversion, becoming one of the greatest saints in the history of Christianity, and a Doctor of the Church. St. Monica is the patron saint of all mothers, widows, and wives (particularly those who suffer spousal abuse).

Her feast day is August 27th.






